# TAFE is a trade star

ST George TAFE has been awarded the highest industry rating for training in the automotive trades, a skill shortage area.

Head teacher Roger Green said the college's automotive and auto electrical section was presented with a three-star rating by the Institute for Trade Skills Excellence.

"This means St George College has now been recognised as one of Australia's premier providers of training for the auto trades," Mr Green said.

"We are very proud of this, particularly as the star rating is assessed by industry at a national level."

The aim of the star rating scheme is to identify the

best training providers in Australia for each industry.

"Most importantly this industry rating will help potential students find out which training providers are specialist centres in their field of interest - in our case automotive trades," Mr Green said.

Enrolments for semester two courses will take place on July 3 and students can now enrol for the certificate IV in automotive mechanical technology, which is being offered at St George College for the first time.
